Responsibilities

- Ensure that assignments are returned promptly with constructive feedback to feed forward including specific comments on strengths and areas for improvement, setting individualized goals with students
- Use formative and summative assessments effectively and with appropriate criteria in order to set realistic and challenging targets for improvement and to inform future teaching
- Set consistently high expectations for student attitudes toward learning and ensure that classrooms are engaging learning spaces
